3.NO Good Work Is Ever Lest-

David wanted to live to see this great pi ece of work done-

Someone will carry it on if we give our best to a good work somebody will build on our foundation—someboudy will take the torch—

Scientists tell us that there is no less of energy in this world....

No good work will be lost- let that be inspiration to every parent- you dreams- your teaching will come to consumation in the son-Solomon will build-

I am like the (Negro preacher) who was preaching on

the creation—he came to describe the frist man, after God created the first man he stood him up by a picket fence to dry—he repeated the statement—one old deacon sitting over there seemed about half a sleep—raised himself & said Preacher was that the first man?——Yes that was the first Well if that was the first man, Reverend who made the Fence?.... New Bro. questions like that always troubles & causes preachers endless pain.

I will not try to interpret your broken dreams tonight yet I have often discovered in conversation, conferences plans, dreams, hopes have ended in defeat. Some lefty purpose had to be abadened—you could not go throught with your aims of life.... Unfulfilled purposes...

No doubt you have been at that point in life when you felt your dreams had been shattered & it was no use going on....

Bible comes to our relief at that point- it brings to us a real experience out of life- this revealing incident is take out of the life David--

He had a desire to build a temple for God and yet was not able to carry it out to completion. He dreamed about it, he looked foreward to it, prepared for it, yet did not see a stone laid in place.

He had dreamed for years and years to build a house to henor God, and he was not allowed to build

What are some of the lessons here for us?

I. A PICTURE OF THE INCOMPLETENESS OF LIFE

The great tradgy of life is not the brevity, but incompleten we are called away right in the midst of our work. The moment things look good, & dreams are in sight, we pass on.

- 1. Simeon—"Lord now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, fro mine eyes have seen thy Sal." not many people can say that.
- 2. Abraham went out of Ur to receive an inheritance & did not get one foot of the land of Canaan

- 3. Jacob- went out on a great quest & didd in a strange
- 4. Moses-Led a great strong nation from bondage toward a land of plenty towards & inheritance. He had dreams hopes, for months he had worked at the task, for years he had prepared for his job--- yet he suffered from BROKEN Dreams -as he never entered the promise land.
- 5. Lord Shaftsbury— one of Englands greatest men devoted life to relief of poor people-when he came to die said to his physcian "I am not afraid to die, my peace is made with God, But I have no one to look after these poor women and children. I want to live"—— life is incomplete
- 6.B.H.Carrell- the founder of Southwestern Seminaryat Ft. Worth Tex. (just before he died said- "Do not for get the seminary, which is for the training of you preachers." felt his job was incomplete. (Today it is the largest seminary in the world)

Men always want to stay lenger in the world and carry out their dreams—great causes are in our hearts ——

II. WHY DAVIDS DREAMS WERE BROKEN

1Chron.22:8

"Nevertheless thou shalt not build---

You can imagine his dominate passion now shattered...

- First-they were unsettled times- emenies on every hand---
- _Second-David was getting on in years-
- _ Third- David had been a man of war, shed much blood.

It would be inconsistent for the saloon man who has gained his money through the blood & suffering of little children should come around and say"Let me build you a church"— or for the sambler who has gained his fortune through prostitution & say let me build a church for you—
God said — David "It would not be fitting for a man of blood, for a man of war to build this house— good that in your hear

Solomon will do the job. He will be a man of peace---

III. DAVIDS REACTION TO GOD'S DECISION

His dreams gone -- he did not murmur against God, he did not protest --

said very well- if I can not build the Temple, while I am here I will do all I can for Solomon- and he mad e great preparation for the building, he gathered materials for his son-

There are no perfect lives in the world today- David was not perfect, nor was Solomon his son after him. none of as are perfect today, only Jesus was such a person.

the unfinished work of the parents will be carried on by the children...

4. The Dream was not for Self---

Proposed this great thong for God----

We dream of great things for ourselves

David wanted this for his children—that coming generation have somewhere to worship.— But more——

David wanted this Temple for God to recognize God at the very center of the nation.....

He desired to realize this before he lay down for his last skeep

5. It was a matter of His HEART ----

This was not something David had down on paper— It was not something that was a fly by night idea—— it was no mushroune

He did not say! I can not do this wo ene else shall"
I cannot do it, let others take the whole burden" no, he collected treasures---

It was in HIS HEART— to honor God and the church of his day. His heart was in his worship of God....First before anything else...

If you want your life to count for much identify your life with X, with His church- put your best into your church. When you put your life in your church you are building the chief cause in the world. Christ church was purchased by the blood of X.

I am always distressed when a man is mores enthusiastis, about other interest than he is his church. Your witness will go further &mean more through the church that anywer in
