Dr. Eugene Hill told of the healing ministry-Refugee camp. Led weeping, can't find mother, Father dead ~~by a bomb~~, China, help me find mother-need help I am blind, no clothes bought larger suit, cut off leggs, sleeves etc. Dr. Hayes Let me see your eyes- Would you like to see... Operation, ba ndages--I can see, I can see.. and we sent this 10 yr. boy to school learn to read and write... Baptist are trying to give medical aid to the sick----- It was later on after this boy had received care and instruction, that he came on day and said my heart now has eyes to see, & they see Jesus.....

Dr. Abernathy told of our relief ministry in Korea. we appreciate the clothing sent--- remember our church collected 2 or 3 bails and shipped to this m.ss. about 4 yrs. ago. told how God is working in Korea- 6 yrs ago 40 churches, today over 200 churches....

Alethia Fuller told of Miss work with heathen tribes... When they come to know X as saviour they burn their idols an old heathen priest was helped in our hospital and saved. and now this priest has gone back to save babies from the river and place them in orphanage... In 1953 The E-Jaw tribe celebrated a festival and they try to get 7 human heads to offer on the JU JU altar, two of our xtians natives were captured and lost their heads to this evil cause, now some of our Miss and xtian natives plan to go to this tribe an preach X..

Mc. Robertson from argintinia told of a service there in a hut... after he had preached 15 people responded by raising their hands... fearing that they did not understand he preached again and extended and invitation want you to stand up----- have you understood me--- yes we understood the first time said a 70 yr. old man, I have a question Why havent you been here years before to tell of Jesus???

He said I had a hard time telling.....

God to give me success, and I begin each day with prayer. Knowing that my success depended upon how I lived before my employees I open each meeting that I have with them with Scripture reading and prayer--- To me this has been the difference

Dr. Taylor, dean of Brownwood college, told how some people today were not very much interested in rel. on the campus. He told of one school where they were having a revival meeting- on mon. had a Rabbi to speak on brotherhood, Tues, Episcopal- on Community activities, Wed. Catholic to preach on world Peace, Meth on Thur. speak on getting the churches together----- NO ONE WAS SAVED. They didn't want any emotional emphasis on the campus or smell of the saw dust trail.....

But in Brownwood we call for students to come down to the mornurs bench and be saved. This is what one of our Baptist colleges is doing....

RUSSIAN Baptist ---Group visiting from Russia. Miss Claudia Ti Tobia spoke at the youth night... Said there were no special youth groups in Russia as they were not permitted to have them among the Baptist.. In all shae said they have 100,000 young people in their churches and they work hard for the Lord. For the most part she said the young people make up the choirs, and they have some orcharcter They get together and sing and play..... she has been study in the english Language for 5 Yrs. and siad t. at their young people preach christ crucified

I shook hands with Dr, Jacob Zedkoff. He brought greetings in the following fashion. Baptist are 90 yrs. old in Russia. since 1905 we have had outside contact with the world... He spoke through and interpreter... Do not believe what all the empty papers say about Russian Baptist. We are Baptist from head to feet There was 28 yrs. we did not have any contact with the out side world but our hearts were with you... Our Baptist work is expiercing a revival. Every Bptist is a worker. Every baptist is a missionary, every old R. Baptist is a missionary, every Young R. Bap. is Miss.. We are preaching Christ and him crucified in Three ways----- First, in our churches Second, in our private homes Third, individually from soul to soul. Urged us to pray for the R. Baptist, that they might build around the banner of the cross as So. Baptist.
