He removed next the hynn book. He talked about how it had helped us in worship, how we could praise God. And the wonderful poetry and music in it.

He put away the pulpit cushion. Then he recalled the great sermon that had helped direct lives. A long line of Christian testimony.

He then moved the flowers. And with them he said, they shed the nature of God's love.

Then he moved the pulnit chairs, with the memory of the children saying, that they had remembered seeing these chairs and old men full of wisdom had looked upon them. And these chairs had been the place of faith and prayer.

Finally, he stended down the pulpit stairs taking with himself the years of patience as he stumbled on the steps.
