

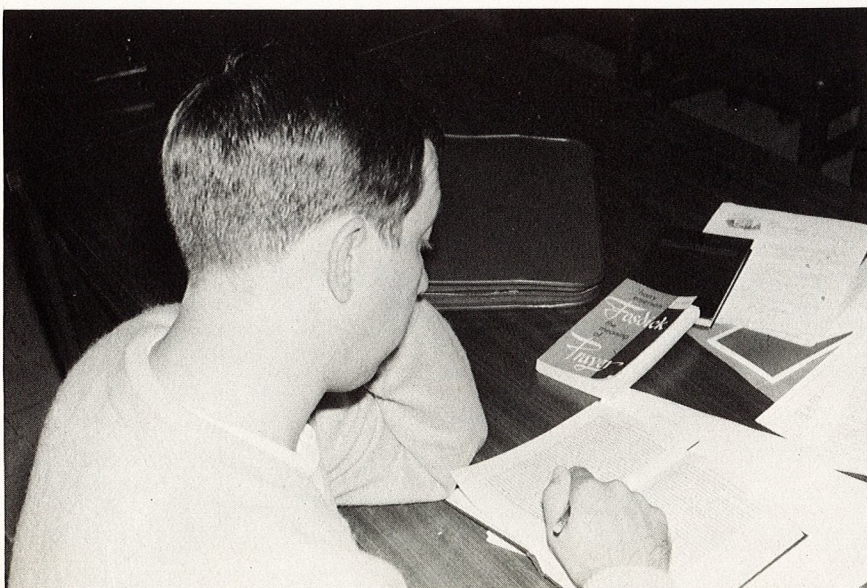
Ridgecrest's Bible Reflects Meditation
